

# MEADOWVIEW CUP 7's 2017

Entry Fee: \$100 a team for the event.

## - REVISED GAME –

Rules: Payouts will go to each team that scores a minimum of 7 **VALID\*** points for any nine hole match on **Thursday, Friday or Saturday**. (This is a change from previous Meadowview Cup contests, please make sure to take note.) There will be increased payouts for incremental scores above 7. 7.5, 8.0, 8.5, and 9.0 will payout more than a 7.

**\*IMPORTANT NOTE: Valid points are earned by playing your opponent with both of them present and participating. Exceptions: If only one opponent player participates on any given hole, (1) They must be the lower of the handicapped players (Zero for no official handicap does not count), or (2) if the higher handicapped player, they must not have had their handicap adjusted lower based on the maximum 12 stroke differential that applies to the teams. (These situations are rare but are important to note to protect the field of competitors).**

If you win 8 holes, you score 8 points in the Meadowview Cup. (We do not limit points that you can earn as may be the rule in the Monte Mayor)

A historical review of previous Monte Mayor events shows that after approximately 450 nine hole matches, teams have scored 7 or more points around 10 times. Do you have what it takes to pound one of your opponents into submission this year?

If we have 70 teams participate, we would have \$7,000 to divide with teams that scored a 7 or above in any 9 hole match. If a team scores 7 twice, they will receive 2 shares of the pot.

Based on history, anyone that puts up 7 points on their opponent could expect 10% of the total pot.

I think it is safe to say this has been one of the better pay outs in the tourney in the past.

The following is an example of how the payouts could occur.

If no 9.0's are earned the amount of money allocated for 9.0's (\$140 in this example) will be added to the total available for 7.0's, same for 8.5, 8.0 and 7.5

The simplest way to look at this game is this: Win 7 points in a match on Thursday, Friday or Saturday and you are in the \$\$\$\$.
