

# **Seville Men's Golf Association (SMGA) Junior Golf Scholarship**

## **Purpose of Seville Men's Golf Association (SMGA)**

The purpose of the SMGA is to promote interaction and good fellowship among the male members of Seville Golf & Country Club and encourage active participation in the game of golf and the Club's events. In addition, when possible, the SMGA shall give back to the game of golf by supporting local charitable organizations and groups in the community.

One of the methods chosen by the SMGA for supporting our local community is this Junior Golf Scholarship Program.

## **Objective of the Junior Golf Scholarship Program**

The goal of the SMGA Junior Golf Award Program is to use some of its financial resources to promote the game of golf by supporting male and female high school golfers who demonstrate good character, good grades and who exhibit a passion/love for the game but who could benefit from the funding to participate at a greater level.

## **Scholarship Award Criteria**

Students eligible for the scholarship must be an active high school student of grade 9 through 12 with a GPA of 3.0 or higher and in good standing with the teaching and coaching staff. Added qualifying criteria such as school or community service or awards will be considered. Students do not have to have parents as members of the Seville Golf and Country Club to participate.

## **Scholarship Committee**

The SMGA Scholarship committee to be composed of a minimum of three members. One of those committee members must a member of the SMGA Board of Directors and will be the Chairman of the committee.

## **Local Schools**

Three major high schools (Perry, Casteel, and Queen Creek) with male and female golf teams and which are geographically close to the Seville Golf and Country Club were chosen for the SMGA Junior Golf Award Program. The size of these schools along with the strengths of their golf program supplies sufficient applicants for the scholarship program.
